Who: Jallianwala Bagh Massacre 102nd Anniversary

What: was observed on 13th April 2021

102 Years Of Jallianwala Bagh Massacre: April 13 marks the day of the Jallianwala Bagh Massacre, and this Tuesday is the 102nd anniversary of the incident. Jallianwala Bagh Massacre refers to the incident that took place in 1919 at Amritsar's Jallianwala Bagh, in which British troops opened fire against thousands of people who had gathered to mark the occasion of Baisakhi. In the massacre, several hundreds were killed and numerous more were injured. The incident is seen as a major turning point in the national freedom movement of India.

After the first World War ended in 1919, Indian leaders believed that the leaders of the country would now be allowed to self-govern. To the contrary, the colonial rulers imposed the Rowlatt Act on March 10, 1919, as per which the government could imprison or confine any person who was associated with any seditious activity without any trial. The passing of this Act led to widespread protests across the country, with Mahatma Gandhi initiating a Satyagraha to oppose the Act.(Read more)

Journalist and human rights advocate Ibn Abdur Rehman, known as I.A. Rehman, passed away in Lahore at the age of 90 on Monday morning.

Several journalists and other public figures took to Twitter to remember the human rights defender, who was also a regular columnist for Dawn.

Rehman started working at a young age, according to human rights activist and former chairperson of the HRCP Zohra Yusuf. She told Images that Rehman worked as editor of the Pakistan Times before joining the HRCP in the early 90s, first as director and later as secretary general.



We always looked to him for guidance and though he was not as active in the past few years, he was always available for help, she said. "He will be deeply missed. He was a rare kind of individual, not just because of his professional capabilities but as a human being." (Read more)

What: Launches India Energy Dashboards Version 2.0

With an aim to provide single-window access to the energy data for the country, government think tank Niti Aayog on Monday launched India Energy Dashboards (IED) Version 2.0, according to an official statement.

While launching the IED, Niti Aayog Vice Chairman Rajiv Kumar said that it is an endeavour to establish a central energy database of the country. 'With the rise of renewables and many other new energy technologies, the interplays between energy supply and demand sectors are now becoming increasingly critical,' he said adding that the scenario building exercise is the key as India needs to seize today's opportunities to build a sustainable tomorrow.

Also speaking at the event, Niti Aayog CEO Amitabh Kant said the goal is to turn data into information, and information into insights to inspire those in a position to make a difference. 'We are moving slowly into an era where big data is the starting point, not the end. So, the IED will continue to evolve and be a pillar around which robust energy decisions are taken in India,' Kant said.(Read more)

What: opens 5G Signal base at World's Highest Radar Station

China has opened a 5G signal base at the Ganbala radar station in the remote Himalayan region of Tibet which is the world's highest manually operated radar station at an elevation of 5,374 meters, the Chinese military's official website reported on Monday.

The mountain is located in Nagarze County in Tibet which is in the vicinity of borders with India and Bhutan.

At the end of last year, the People's Liberation Army started to coordinate with civilian enterprises to launch 5G base station construction in Ganbala to solve the difficulty of network access for the border defence troops, the website said.

The stable and high-speed 5G signal enables the soldiers in the deep mountains to keep up with the information society, leaving the monotonous and boring life on the border, it said.(Read more)

Who: Former banker Guillermo Lasso

What: wins Ecuador's presidential election

When: published on 12th April 2021

Former banker Guillermo Lasso outperformed all polls on Sunday to win Ecuador's presidential elections. While surveys had predicted a head-to-head race between Lasso and Andrés Arauz, the candidate backed by former Ecuadorian president Rafael Correa, the conservative won the second round of the election with a five-point lead. With 98.4% of ballots counted, Lasso has won 52.5% of the vote, while Arauz has taken 47.5%. The results are a huge blow to Correa, who had handpicked Arauz to lead the return of the so-called "Citizens' Revolution," the political project launched by the former president.

Correa had been following the campaign from Belgium, where he has been living with his Belgian wife since 2017 when he ended his third term in office. The former president, who has been convicted of bribery and corruption charges, bet everything on Arauz, but lost. Lasso's victory also affects the region, as it curbs the recent leftist shift in politics seen in South America with the presidential wins of Alberto Fernández in Argentina and Luis Arce in Bolivia.(Read more)

What: finalises 110-MW solar park, makes net-zero pledge

Indian independent power producer ReNew Power Pvt Ltd this week commissioned a 110-MW solar power plant in the state of Rajasthan and pledged to achieve net-zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050.

ReNew Power unveiled the completion of the solar project on Wednesday, saying that it has signed a power purchase agreement (PPA) for its output with Solar Energy Corporation of India at a tariff of INR 2.49 (USD 0.033/EUR 0.028) per kWh.

The plant in question is located in the Jaisalmer District of Rajasthan and utilises monocrystalline and bifacial solar modules. With it, ReNew Power now has 500 MW of total solar capacity in the state and is looking to reach 2.3 GW by 2023.(Read more)
