What: shatter Michael Phelps' world record in 200 butterfly

When: published on 24th July 2019

Michael Phelps owned the world record in the 200-meter butterfly for 18 straight years. And now, thanks to 19-year-old Hungarian swimmer Kristof Milak, it's been broken. Shockingly shattered, actually.

At the FINA world championships Wednesday in South Korea, Milak clocked a time of 1:50.73, shaving .78 seconds off Phelps' world record.

In his signature event-and the only one he competed in at all five of his Olympic appearances-Phelps first set the record in 2001 as a 15-year-old, becoming the youngest male swimming to break a world record. He broke his own mark seven times, and most recently, he dropped the record time down to 1:51.51 in 2009 before it stood for a decade.

The IITs Madras and Kharagpur, Delhi University, University of Hyderabad, Amritha Vishwa Vidyapeetham and VIT are among the 20 institutions recommended for the grant of the Institute of Eminence status by the University Grants Commission.

However, the UGC denied the tag to five private universities — Azim Premji University, Ashoka University, KREA University, Indian Institute for Human Settlements and the Indian Institute of Public Health — on the grounds that they have not been placed in any global or national rankings. Since their exclusion left a vacant slot on the list of private universities given the tag, the Satya Bharti Foundation — telecom major Airtel's philanthropic arm — became the second greenfield institution to be given IoE status, after Jio Institute which is backed by the Reliance Foundation.

The UAPA Bill was introduced in the Lower House by Union home minister Amit Shah on 8 July, just two weeks after the Union cabinet had cleared it. The Bill amends the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, providing special procedures to deal with

terrorist activities, and individuals and groups that foster terrorism in India. It will now be tabled in the Rajya Sabha, where it awaits passage.

Bharti Airtel will shut down its 3G network across India's 22 telecom circles by March 2020, and increase its focus on providing 4G services, a top company official said.

The company started the process last month, when it wound down the 3G network in the Kolkata circle. It, however, continues to provide 2G services for feature phone users.

"This has worked very well in Kolkata. Now we will do this process across India. By September, we will shut down six to seven circles and by March, the entire 3G network pan-India will shut down," Bharti Airtel chief executive Gopal Vittal said in the post-earnings call with analysts on Friday.

This marks the first phase-out of the 3G technology in India, which is now increasingly moving to 4G, triggered by the entry of 4G-only Reliance Jio in September 2016. Rival Vodafone Idea continues to provide 2G, 3G and 4G services.
