Explanations:

1.

All other numbers consist of odd digits only. Hence, option D is correct.

2.

Each of the numbers except 345, is one more than the cube of a certain number. Hence, option C is correct.

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3.

In all othe<mark>r numb</mark>ers, the last digit is the sum of the first two. Hence, option B is correct.

4.

In all other numbers, the sum of the first and the last digits is equal to the sum of other two digits.

Hence, option A is correct.

5.

Each of the given numbers is a prime number. But the number obtained on reversing the digits of each of the numbers except 23, is also a prime number. Hence, option C is correct.

6.

In all other numbers, the middle digit is equal to the product of other two digits. Hence, option D is correct.

7.

This is the only number in which a digit has been repeated. Hence, option D is correct.

8.

In all other numbers, the first and the last digits are the same. Hence, option B is correct.

9.

131 is the only prime number in the group. Hence, option C is correct.

10.

In all other numbers, the last digit is one more than the first digit. Hence, option A is correct.
