Directions: Study the following information carefully and answer the questions given beside:

In a certain code language "hunger and poverty remain" is coded as "ner gup jil mub", "people count poverty records" is coded as " abc gup xyz def" , "count remain unchanged records" is coded as "buf ner def xyz", "people and poverty rate" is coded as "abc mub for gup".

Questions :

1. Find the code for "hunger"?

- A. gup B. jil C. mub D. Either B or C E. None of these

2. What is the code for "poverty unchanged"?

- A. buf jil B. buf ner C. ner gup D. gup buf E. None of these

3. Find the code for "rate and records"?

- A. for jil mun B. ner mub for C. for mub def D. def ner mub E. Can't be determined

4. Find the code for "hunger rate"?

- A. ner for B. jil gup C. jil for D. mub for E. Can't be determined

5. Code 'ner' stands for which of the following?

- A. rate B. remain C. count D. unchanged E. Can't be determined

Correct Answers:

1	2	3	4	5
B	D	E	C	B

Common explanations :

“hunger and poverty remain” is coded as “ner gup jil mub” ----- (1)

“people count poverty records” is coded as “ abc gup xyz def” ----- (2)

“count remain unchanged records” is coded as “buf ner def xyz” ----- (3)

“people and poverty rate” is coded as “abc mub for gup” ----- (4)

From statements (1) and (2) we get:

poverty – gup ----- (5)

From statements (1), (4) and (5) we get:

and – mub ----- (6)

From statements (2), (4) and (5) we get:

people – abc ----- (7)

From statements (4), (5), (6) and (7) we get:

rate – for ----- (8)

From statements (1) and (3) we get:

remain – ner ----- (9)

From statements (1), (5), (6) and (9) we get:

hunger – jil ----- (10)

From statements (2), (5) and (7) we get:

count records – xyz def ---- (11) in no specific order

From (3), (9) and (11), we get:

unchanged – buf ---- (12)



Answers :

1. From the following explanation 'hunger' can be coded as jil.
Hence option B is correct.
2. From the following explanation 'poverty unchanged' can be coded as gup buf.
Hence option D is correct.
3. From the following explanation 'rate and records' can't be coded as we don't know a specific code for "records".
Hence option E is correct.
4. From the following explanation 'hunger rate' is coded as "jil for".
Hence option C is correct.
5. From the following explanation 'ner' is the code for "remian".
Hence option B is correct.
