Sarkaria Commission was set up in June 1983 by the central government of India. The Sarkaria Commission's charter was to examine the relationship and balance of power between state and central governments in the country and suggest changes within the framework of Constitution of India. The Commission was so named as it was headed by Justice Rajinder Singh Sarkaria, a retired judge of the Supreme Court of India. The other two members of the committee were Shri B. Sivaraman and Dr S.R. Sen.

Balwant Raj Mehta Committee was appointed in 1957 (January) and submitted its report in 1957 (November). It recommended three tier system of Panchayati Raj.

Sachar Committee was commissioned to prepare a report on the latest social, economic and educational conditions of the Muslim community of India in 2005. The head of the Committee was former Chief Justice of the Delhi High Court Rajinder Sachar.

According to the Sachar Committee report, some of the major concerns are:

1. The status of Indian Muslims are below the conditions of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.

2. The overall percentage of Muslims in bureaucracy in India is just 2.5% whereas Muslims constitute above 14% of the population of India.

Hence, the option C is correct.

In December 1977, the Janata Government appointed a committee on Panchayati Raj institutions under the chairmanship of Ashok Mehta. The committee submitted its report in August 1978 and made 132 recommendations to revive and strengthen the declining Panchayati Raj system in the country. As a result of this report, the Indian states of Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, and West Bengal passed new legislation.
