According to the statement, the country's installed renewable energy (RE) capacity stands at 150.05 GW, while its nuclear energy-based installed electricity capacity is 6.78 GW.

In addition to the refurbishment, the company deals with the manufacture and supply of guided missiles and associated equipment, underwater weapon systems, airborne weapon systems, ground support equipment and product life cycle support.

BDL has now confirmed the signing of a fresh 10-year contract with the Indian Army. The firm had earlier built-up its in-house Research and Development capabilities. According to the release, the firm has been primarily focusing on design and engineering activities while also analysing emerging technologies like Artificial Intelligence to develop futuristic weapons for the Armed Forces. The company have been receiving leads from several countries for its products after it exported torpedoes to a "friendly foreign country".

Meanwhile, Maharashtra's annual growth rate stood at nearly half of Gujarat's at 7.5 percent for the same time period and its GVA for manufacturing stood at Rs 4.34 lakh crore in FY20.
