What: was observed on June 8

This is the second year of a fully virtual celebration of the United Nations World Oceans Day due to the coronavirus pandemic, which hit the world last year. The UN has asked people to join the virtual event through a link.

India and the UK are promoting industrial energy efficiency under the Clean Energy Ministerial's (CEM) Industrial Deep Decarbonisation Initiative (IDDI), the Ministry of Power told the media.

Chile is organising the 12th Clean Energy Ministerial (CEM) in virtual mode from May 31-June 6, the ministry said.

This year, India and the United Kingdom launched a new workstream to promote industrial energy efficiency under the CEM's IDDI coordinated by the United Nations Industrial Development Organisation (UNIDO).

According to the ministry, the goal of the new collaboration is to infuse green technologies and boost demand for low-carbon industrial material. The IDDI initiative has been supported by Canada and Germany, with more countries expected to join soon.

What: approves 500 million dollar program to help boost India's MSME sector

When: published on 8th June 2021



The World Bank has approved a USD 500 million program to help boost India's MSME sector. The programme targets improvements in the performance of five lakh 50 thousand MSMEs. Out of some 58 million MSMEs in the country, more than 40 per cent lack access to formal sources of finance. The MSME sector is the backbone of the country's economy, contributing 30 percent of India's GDP and 40 percent of exports.

The USD 500 million Raising and Accelerating Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise (MSME) Performance (RAMP) Program is the World Bank's second intervention in this sector. The first being the Rs 750 million MSME Emergency Response Program, approved in July last year. World Bank Country Director Junaid Ahmad said, the MSME sector, a critical backbone of India's economy, has been hard hit by the COVID-19 pandemic. The RAMP program will provide better access to finance and working capital for MSMEs by strengthening the receivable financing markets. It will also scale up online dispute resolution mechanisms to address the problem of delayed payments.

Shahid garnered 143 votes while Rassoul received 48 votes out of the 191 votes polled.

In his victory speech, Shahid referred to his upcoming term as "Presidency of hope". "We have always worked for a better tomorrow. This unrelenting spirit, this unyielding hope - this is the Maldivian way, the Maldivian ethos. One that I am keen to bring in the presidency of hope," he said.

An alumnus of the National Defense Academy, Khadakwasla, Pune, he was commissioned into the Indian Navy in Jan 1987. He is a graduate of the Defence Services Staff College, Wellington, Naval War College, Karanja, and Naval Command College, Newport, Rhode Island, USA.

The Flag Officer is a specialist in Anti-Submarine Warfare (ASW) and has served on frontline warships of the Navy as ASW Officer and later as the Executive Officer and Principal Warfare Officer of Guided Destroyer INS Mysore

He has commanded the missile corvette INS Kora, the missile frigate INS Shivalik and the aircraft carrier INS Viraat. He has held important staff appointments in IHQ MoD (Navy) in the Directorate of Staff Requirements, Directorate of Personnel, and the Directorate of Net-Centric Operations.

On promotion to the rank of Rear Admiral in Feb 2016, he was appointed as the Assistant Chief of Integrated Defence Staff (Int – A) at HQ IDS, New Delhi, and subsequently as the Chief Staff Officer (Operations) in Headquarters, Western Naval Command, Flag Officer Commanding Maharashtra Naval Area and Flag Officer Sea Training.

Sahai hadn't applied for the job and his name did not figure in the list of candidates that the panel sent out invites for interviews last month.

What: inks pacts with Gujarat govt for implementing ₹24,000 crore projects

Public sector undertaking Indian Oil Corporation (IOC) signed six memorandum of understanding (MoUs) with the Gujarat government in Gandhinagar on Monday to invest a sum of Rs 24,000 crore in expanding refining capacity at its Koyali refinery in Vadodara, and adding plants to produce polypropelene and lube oil base stock. The ventures are likely to create direct and indirect employment opportunities for 25,000 persons.

Union minister for petroleum, natural gas and steel, Dharmendra Pradhan and chief minister Vijay Rupani presided over the ceremony of 'Investment Promotion' between the state government and Indian Oil for setting up a petrochemical and lube integration (LuPech) project and acrylics/oxo alcohol project along with other infrastructure projects at Gujarat Refinery," a statement said on Monday.

Expanding refining capacity by 4.3 million tonnes per annum to 18 million tonnes and adding plants to produce 500,000 tonnes per annum of polypropylene and 2,35,000 tonnes of lube oil base stock at the site would see a total investment of about Rs 24,000 crore.
