101. During the inaugural address at the 1st edition of 'Mobility Next Hyderabad Summit', a part of the Hyderabad E-Mobility Week, Telangana Minister for IT, Industries and Commerce, K. T. Rama Rao, launched India's first new mobility-focused cluster called "Telangana Mobility Valley (TMV)" which aims to attract investments of around Rs 50,000 crore and generate more than 4 lakh jobs in the next 5 years in the state. TMV will create best in class infrastructure making Telangana the most competitive destination for both manufacturing and R&D in India. [{Read more}](#)

On February 8, with a growing concern for health and increasing demand for organic food, the Jammu and Kashmir government launched a vital programme, "Alternate Agriculture System for Sustainability", to support its farmers and promote sustainable agriculture in the Union Territory. The government is investing in a project that will boost organic food production and increase economic returns for farmers in the UT. This is a part of the government's larger efforts to create a safer, cleaner and more sustainable environment for agriculture and food production in the region. The government has kept a budget of Rs 84 Crore to support the program over the next 5 years. The program will also provide training to 10,000 farmer families in organic farming and establish 200 commercial and 3000 low-cost vermicompost units and 100 Integrated Organic Farming System Units. 103. On February 6, the Central Government constituted a 16-member inter-ministerial committee to examine the need for a separate law on competition in digital markets. The panel has been tasked with submitting its report, including a draft Digital Competition Act, within 3 months. The Inter-ministerial Committee will be headed by Manoj Govil MCA Secretary. Also the Panel has been tasked to study the practices of leading players/ systemically important digital intermediaries (SIDIs) which limit or have the potential to cause harm in digital markets, sources added. Besides, the Standing Committee on Finance, headed by BJP MP Jayant Sinha, recently recommended the enactment of the Digital Competition Act. [{Read more}](#)

Organised by National School of Drama (NSD), the prestigious international theatre festival will be held in Delhi, Jaipur, Rajahmundry, Ranchi, Guwahati, Jammu, Srinagar, Bhopal, Nashik and Kevadia. The closing ceremony was scheduled to take place in Kevadia on the 26th of February. 105. On February 6, the government has passed an order to convert Adjusted Gross Revenue (AGR) dues of telecom services provider, Vodafone Idea (Vi) into equities for nearly ₹16,133.2 Crore. This conversion of AGR dues into equities is likely to make the Government of India the largest shareholder in this loss-making telecom services provider. At present, the promoter and promoter group in Vodafone Idea holds a 74.99% stake, while public shareholding is at 25.01% as of December 31, 2022. Post this transaction, the promoter’s shareholding will trim down to 50%. [{Read more}](#)

On February 5, the Gujarat government signed an agreement with the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) to conduct the ‘Programme for International Student Assessment (PISA)’ test for the students of government schools. The agreement was signed in the presence of Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel and OECD’s Paris director Andreas Schliecher. Gujarat is the first state in the country to sign such an agreement. The PISA measures 15-year-olds’ ability to use reading, mathematics and science knowledge and skills to meet real-life challenges. [{Read more}](#)

The visa application process facilitation center has the capacity to handle more than 1.20 lakh visa applications every year. Moreover, “VFS Global Academy” has also been opened in Lucknow where VFS Global, in collaboration with the Indian Hotels Company Limited, will train the youth of the state in hospitality services as per the skill development program of the state government. 109. On February 10, Reliance Industries (RIL) and Ashok Leyland unveiled India's first Hydrogen Internal Combustion Engine (H2-ICE)-powered heavy duty Truck at the India Energy Week in Bengaluru. Heavy duty trucks are the biggest emitter, producing 60% of road-freight CO2 emissions, which is expected to increase to 66% by 2050. On February 7, the Directorate General of GST Intelligence (DGGI) and the National Forensic Sciences University (NFSU) signed an MoU for setting up digital forensic laboratories along with exchange of information and knowledge, technological advancement and skill development in the field of digital forensics. DGGI is the apex intelligence organisation, under the Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs (CBIC), for collection and dissemination of information and for taking necessary measures to check evasion of GST. NFSU is an institution of national importance established to promote studies and research in forensic sciences and related fields. This program was launched during the IEEE Standards Association (IEEE SA) Workshop centred on “Next Generation Connectivity”. This platform will offer specially-tailored certification program that aims at providing quality learning in diverse areas of Telecom. The key focus is on building skills that would accelerate the participation of students, academia, technologists, industry, start-ups and other relevant stakeholders in developing globally-competitive Telecom technologies and solutions. On February 2, Pakistan Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif inaugurated the third unit of the Karachi Nuclear Power Plant (KANUPP) worth USD 2.7 billion built with China’s assistance under the ambitious China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC). Known as the K-3, the plant will provide 1,100 megawatts of electricity to the national grid. The construction work on two nuclear power reactors, K-2 and K-3, was started in August 2015 and in May 2016 respectively. The USD 60 billion CPEC is part of China’s ambitious Belt and Road Initiative (BRI), a pet project of Chinese President Xi Jinping. [{Read more}](#)

On February 7, India and the European Union announced setting up of a new 'Trade and Technology Council (TTC)' that is expected to facilitate exchange of critical technologies relating to an array of domains, including artificial intelligence, quantum computing, semiconductors and cybersecurity. The TTC with India is the European Union's second such technology partnership after the first one with the United States that was firmed up in June 2021. Under the TTC, three working groups have been established. The first working group is on strategic technologies, digital governance and digital connectivity while the second one will cover green and clean energy technologies. The third working group is on trade, investment and resilient value chains. The TTC will be co-chaired on the Indian side by the ministers for external affairs, commerce and industry, and communications, electronics and information technology. [{Read more}](#)

On February 5, the United States shot down a Chinese surveillance balloon over the Atlantic Ocean as it crossed the continental America after hovering over its skies from Montana to South Carolina. The balloon, which was being used by the People's Republic of China in an attempt to surveil strategic sites in the continental United States, was brought down over the water off the coast of South Carolina in US airspace. This action was taken in coordination, and with the full support, of the Canadian government.

117. As of February 6, thousands of people were killed as well as trapped under rubble in Turkey and Syria after a 7.8 magnitude earthquake. The first earthquake was big - it was classified as 'major' on the official magnitude scale. The quake struck at a depth of 10 km near the southern Turkish city of Kahramanmaras. Currently, the combined death toll in Turkey and Syria passed 47,000, including more than 41,000 in Turkey and over 5,800 in Syria. Aid workers are among those killed. The humanitarian community estimates that 8.8 million people live in areas most affected by the earthquake in Syria. [{Read more}](#)

The ISA and Ministry of Earth Sciences also exchanged PMN (Polymetallic Nodules) Exploration Extension Contract in presence of Dr. Jitendra Singh. This contract was initially signed on 25th March, 2002 for a period of 15 years, which later was extended by the authority twice for 5 years period, during 2017 and 2022. [{Read more}](#)

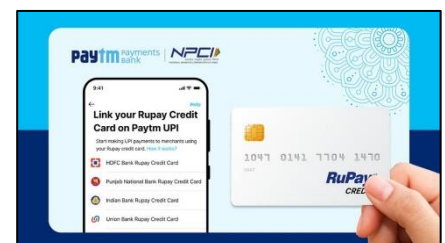
