501. On January 24, Chandigarh Administrator and Punjab Governor Banwarilal Purohit inaugurated north India's largest floating solar project of 2000kWp in Chandigarh. The 2000kWp floating solar power plant at Water Works in Sector 39 has been commissioned at a cost of Rs 11.70 crore. He also opened the 500kWp floating solar power plant installed over the Dhanas lake in Chandigarh. Both the projects have been designed and executed by CREST (Chandigarh Renewable Energy and Science and Technology Promotion Society) and will generate a minimum of 35 lakh units (kWh) per year with 20% module efficiency. {Read more}

APEDA is identifying agri products that can be sourced from the Gangetic, Brahmaputra, Cauvery and Godavari River basins, among others, across India. India, which is currently the 8th largest exporter of agri products, aims to be among the top five by 2030. {Read more}

On January 24, Union Minister of Petroleum and Natural Gas and Housing and Urban Affairs, Hardeep Singh Puri, inaugurated the demo-run of Inland Water Vessel named "SB Gangadhar" powered by Methanol blended Diesel (MD15) in the Brahmaputra in Guwahati, in a run-up to India Energy Week 2023 (IEW 2023) to be held in Bengaluru from February 6 to 8, 2023. The marine vessel is equipped with two Ruston make diesel engines. The work is in progress to set up Coal-to-Methanol plants in India using indigenous technology, which is being developed by BHEL (Hyderabad and Trichy), Thermax, and IIT Delhi. {Read more}

On January 25, NITI Aayog's Atal Innovation Mission (AIM), Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) and Intel India have collaborated to bring a change in the Education Sector by embedding future skills, such as artificial intelligence (AI), by launching AloT Integration in School Curriculum. The main aim is to align the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020's guidance to increase the pace of tech integration for youth, the need to bridge the future skills gap in the country, and optimise the current infrastructure towards making India AI-ready. {Read more}

505. On January 26, the Assam Cabinet has decided to book/prosecute men who marry minor girls under stringent laws prescribing imprisonment from two years to life. Men marrying girls between the age of 14 and 18 will be booked under the 'Prohibition of Child Marriage Act, 2006' with a minimum sentence period of two years. While the men marrying girls below 14 years of age will be booked under the 'Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, 2012', entailing life punishment. As per the National Family Health Survey-5 report, an average of 31.8% of girls in Assam get married at the prohibited age and 11.7% of them become mothers before adulthood compared to the national average of 23.3% and 6.8%, respectively. The legal age for marriage is 18 years for women and 21 for men. Dhubri in Western Assam tops the list of districts with 50% of girls getting married and 22% of them becoming mothers before they turn 18. {Read more}

506. On January 25, the Government has approved a proposal for the sale of 30 Lakh Metric Tonnes of wheat under the 'Open Market Sale Scheme - Domestic (OMSS-D)' to control prices of wheat. Wheat will be offered to the flour millers, and bulk buyers through e-auction for a maximum quantity of 3,000 Metric Tonnes per buyer, per auction, from an FCI Region under e-auction. {Read more}

507. Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma announced that the central government has decided to put forth the name of Assam's Charaideo moidams (pyramids) burial sites for addition to United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization's (UNESCO) World Heritage Sites list. If selected, 90 royal burials at Charaideo will be the only cultural heritage site in the North East to get the coveted status. The Charaideo moidams are royal burial sites of the Ahom dynasty, which ruled over much of Assam and the North East from 1228 to 1826 AD. {Read more}

508. On January 24, Mahanadi Coalfield Limited (MCL), a subsidiary of Coal India, announced to invest Rs 12,000 Crore in Odisha to set up a coal-based power plant; and will set up Greenfield aluminum. Moreover, the company is in the process of mining aluminum ore, bauxite, and then converting it to alumina and then into aluminum. The tentative size of the mine would be 3 million tonnes (MT) per annum. {Read more}

509. Prime Minister Narendra Modi named 21 largest unnamed islands in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands after Param Vir Chakra awardees. The largest unnamed island was named after the first Param Vir Chakra awardee, Major Somnath Sharma. The second largest unnamed island was named after the second Param Vir Chakra awardee, and so on. At an online event on the occasion of Subhas Chandra Bose's birth anniversary, Modi also unveiled the model of a proposed memorial dedicated to Bose, to be set up in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The proposed memorial will be set up on Ross Island, which was renamed as Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Dweep in 2018. {Read more}

510. On January 23, Kerala health department confirmed two cases of Norovirus, a highly-contagious gastrointestinal illness, in the Ernakulam district. Norovirus is a virus that leads to gastroenteritis or stomach flu. According to the health department, two Class 1 students have tested positive for norovirus. Norovirus is a zoonotic disease, which is mainly transmitted through close contact with people who have been infected, or by touching contaminated surfaces. It can also spread by eating food that has been prepared or handled by someone with a stomach bug. {Read more}

The Jal Jeevan Mission aims to provide safe and adequate drinking water through individual household tap connections by 2024 to all households in rural India. The scheme has a financial outlay of ₹3.60 lakh crore, with the Centre funding 50% of the cost with States and Union Territories. {Read more}

- 11 Crore rural households have been provided with a tap water connection under the Jal Jeevan Mission (as of Jan 2023)
- JJM aims to provide safe & adequate drinking water through individual household tap connections by 2024

512. The Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) government in Punjab launched its first major education project, 'Schools of Eminence'. Under the project, the AAP government will upgrade existing government schools into 'Schools of Eminence' for classes 9 to 12. The government plans to upgrade nearly 110 government schools as 'Schools of Eminence' in Phase 1. The AAP government in its first budget in June 2022 had set aside a fund of Rs 200 Cr for 'Schools of Eminence' and said that these schools will be equipped with superlative infrastructure and will be at par with international standards. The project is inspired by Delhi's 'Schools of Specialized Excellence', which also conduct admissions at the Class 9 level. {Read more} Smart Points:

513. On January 20, the National AIDS Control Organisation (NACO) in Odisha's Bhubaneswar formed the largest Human Red Ribbon Chain in the Kalinga stadium to raise awareness regarding the disease. The awareness programme was organised by the Odisha State AIDS Control Society, Health & Family Welfare Department of the Odisha government under the leadership of NACO in coordination with the Department of Sports & Youth Services & Hockey India. Besides the formation of 'largest human red ribbon chain' in the gallery, Audio Visual (AV) materials were scrolled to disseminate the



messages related to HIV/AIDS and the National AIDS Toll-Free helpline - 1097. This event created a massive impact among 25,000 plus spectators inside the stadium and millions of virtual audiences around the globe through television and Over The Top (OTT) platforms. In order to achieve Sustainable Development Goal 3.3 of ending AIDS as a public health threat by 2030, awareness generation activities are being strengthened among the general public as well as the High-Risk Groups in Odisha about the services offered under the umbrella of the National AIDS Control Programme. {Read more}

515. The United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) announced to dedicate the "International Day of Education 2023" to Afghan girls and women. International Day of Education is observed on January 24. According to UNESCO, currently, around 80% of school-aged Afghan girls and young women are out of school under the Taliban rule, as they denied them access to secondary schools and universities. According to a UNICEF report released in August, the fact that girls in Afghanistan are deprived of secondary education has cost the country's economy at least \$500 million over the past 12 months, which amounts to 2.5% of GDP. The fifth International Day of Education was celebrated on 24 January 2023 under the theme "To Invest in People, Prioritize Education". {Read more}

The investment of 40 million Canadian dollars (\$32 million) will enable Xanadu Quantum Technologies Inc., a Toronto-based Canadian quantum computing company, to develop the quantum computer which will have the potential to provide world leading capabilities to help solve complex data problems and could be used in a variety of sectors such as finance, transportation, environmental modelling, and health. {Read more}

The status, awarded by a UNESCO panel meeting in Paris, is designed to help protect Odesa's cultural heritage, which has been under threat since Russia's invasion, and enable access to financial and technical international aid. {Read more}

The T+1 settlement cycle means that trade-related settlements must be done within a day, or 24 hours, of the completion of a transaction. Until 2001, stock markets had a weekly settlement system. The markets then moved to a rolling settlement system of T+3, and then to T+2 in 2003. {Read more}

In January 2023, the National Statistical Office (NSO), under the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, released the First Advance Estimates (FAE) of National Income at both Constant (2011-12) and Current Prices, for the financial year 2022-23. The First Advance Estimates of GDP, introduced in 2016-17 to serve as essential inputs to the Budget exercise, is based on limited data and compiled using the Benchmark-Indicator Method. Real GDP or GDP at Constant (2011-12) Prices in the year 2022-23 is estimated at ₹157.60 lakh crore. The growth in real GDP during 2022-23 is estimated at 7%. Nominal GDP or GDP at Current Prices in the year 2022-23 is estimated at ₹273.08 lakh crore. The growth in nominal GDP during 2022-23 is estimated at 15.4%. The Gross/Net National Income (NNI) of India is estimated to rise by 6.6 % in FY23. {Read more}

548. 5 billion people globally remain unprotected from harmful trans-fat, according to the report titled "Countdown to 2023 - WHO Report on Global Trans Fat Elimination 2022". The report is an annual status report published by the World Health Organization (WHO) in collaboration with Resolve to Save Lives, to track progress towards the goal of trans fat elimination in 2023. The WHO first called for the global elimination of industrially produced trans-fat in 2018, with an elimination target set for 2023. 43 countries have now implemented best-practice policies for tackling trans-fat in food, with 2.8 billion people protected globally. Industrially produced trans-fat (also called industrially produced trans-fatty acids) is commonly found in packaged foods, baked goods, cooking oils and spreads. Trans fat intake is responsible for up to 5,00,000 premature deaths from coronary heart disease each year around the world. There are two best-practice policy alternatives: A mandatory national limit of 2 grams of industrially produced trans-fat per 100 grams of total fat in all foods; and a mandatory national ban on the production or use of partially hydrogenated oils (a major source of trans fat) as an ingredient in all foods. {Read more}
