National & States Affairs

401. On January 19, Prime Minister Narendra Modi visited both Karnataka and Maharashtra to inaugurate and lay the foundation stone of various development projects. PM Modi started from Kalaburagi and Yadgir districts of Karnataka. The foundation stone of Yadgir multi-village drinking water supply scheme was laid by PM Modi under Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) with an outlay of more than Rs 2050 Crore. A Water Treatment Plant of 117 MLD will be built under the scheme. Prime Minister also inaugurated 'Narayanpur Left Bank Canal - Extension Renovation and Modernisation Project (NLBC-ERM)'. In Malkhed village of Kalaburagi district, PM Modi distributed "Title deeds" (hakku patra) to the eligible beneficiaries of these newly declared revenue villages. Prime Minister also laid the foundation stone of the 71 km section of NH-150C. This six-lane Greenfield road project is also part of Surat-Chennai Expressway. While in Mumbai, PM Modi inaugurated and laid the foundation stone of projects worth around ₹38,800 Crore. To provide seamless urban mobility, he also dedicated to the nation Mumbai Metro Rail Lines 2A and 7, worth around ₹12,600 crore. During the visit, Mr. Modi launched MUMBAI 1 Mobile App and National Common Mobility Card (Mumbai 1). The app will facilitate ease of travel, can be shown at the entry gates of metro stations and supports digital payment to buy tickets through UPI. He further laid the foundation stone of 7 sewage treatment plants, which will be built at a cost of around ₹17,200 Crore. PM also laid the foundation stone for the redevelopment of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus. PM Narendra Modi inaugurated 20 Hinduhridaysamrat Balasaheb Thackeray Aapla Dawakhana in Mumbai. {Read more}

402. On January 21, Pune Metro is all set to complete work on India's deepest underground metro station, the Civil Court Interchange Station, in the city by February and make it operational by the end of March. The station is 33.1 metre (108.59 feet) deep. In the first phase, the interchange station for Vanaz to Ramwadi Line 1 and Pimpri Chinchwad to Swargate Line 2 will meet. {Read more}

403. Petroleum Minister Hardeep Singh Puri announced that the phased roll-out of E20 (20% ethanol blending in gasoline) will begin on April 1, 2023. The proposed roll-out will give further impetus to the government's plans of achieving the level of 20% ethanol blending in the overall petrol supply in the country by ethanol supply year (ESY) 2025-2026. India is on track to contribute 25% of global ethanol demand by 2040. India has increased the ethanol blending in petrol from 1.53% in 2013-14 to 10.17% in 2022. To achieve 20% blending by 2025, the country needs 10.2-11 billion litres of ethanol. This would require a production capacity of around 14.5 billion litres because some production has to be kept aside for starch and chemical industry. Moreover, the centre has increased the rate for CBG plants under the SATAT scheme from Rs 46 per kg to Rs 54 per kg. The government is also investing Rs 19,744 Cr into the National Green Hydrogen Mission for developing green hydrogen production capacity of at least 5 MMT (million metric tonnes) per annum. {Read more}

404. On January 20, Higher Education Minister in Kerala R. Bindu announced that girl students above the age of 18 years would get maternity leave of 60 days. The required attendance percentage for female students will be 73%, including the menstrual leave, as against 75% earlier. The state government is also considering granting menstrual leaves in all the state varsities. {Read more}

405. On January 17, NHPC submitted the pre-feasibility report (PFR) for India's largest hydro power project, the 'Upper Siang Multipurpose Storage Project' (11 GW) in Arunachal Pradesh. The project that is central to counter China's ambitious water diversion scheme of the Siang River that feeds downstream into the Brahmaputra is expected to constructed as a joint venture with state-run NEEPCO or the government of Arunachal Pradesh. The PFR was submitted to the government on 30 December, 2022. The storage project will be able to store 9-10 billion cubic metres (BCM) of water. China plans to construct a 60 GW Dam on the Yarlung Tsangpo river amid the push to achieve its net zero target of 2060, as also to utilize the fresh water available in Southern China. {Read more}

406. The India-Bangladesh Friendship Pipeline (IBFPL) will start supplying diesel to Bangladesh on an experimental basis from June, 2023. About 131.5 Km long pipeline has been constructed for exporting diesel from India to Bangladesh. Out of this, 126.5 Km pipeline is in Bangladesh and 5 Km is in India. The international pipeline will carry diesel from the Siliguri based marketing terminal of the Numaligarh Refinery Limited to Parbatipur depot of Bangladesh Petroleum Corporation (BPC). The pipeline has a capacity of 1 million metric tonne per annum (MMTPA). {Read more}

407. On January 18, Bharti Airtel Group in association with the government of Telangana announced an investment to the tune of Rs 2,000 crore to set up a large hyperscale data center in Hyderabad. Through its Data Center arm, Nxtra Data Centers, the group will invest an amount of Rs 2000 Cr as capital investment for the infrastructure which will further attract investments from their customers. The facility will be a hyperscale data center with a capacity of 60 megawatts (MW) of IT load for the first phase. It will incorporate the latest technologies in cooling and security. The project is estimated to be established in the next 5-7 years. The announcement was made at the Telangana Lounge at Davos. {Read more}

408. The 8th India International Science Festival-2022 (IISF) was held from January 21 to 24 at the Maulana Azad National Institute of Technology (MANIT) in Bhopal in Madhya Pradesh. It was inaugurated by Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan and organised by the Union Ministry of Science and Technology, Ministry of Earth Sciences, Department of Atomic Energy, Department of Space and MP government in association with Vijnana Bharati (VIBHA). "Marching towards Amrit Kaal with Science, Technology and Innovation" was the theme of the event. As part of the event, 'Vigyanika-Science Literature Festival' was also organised on January 22-23



by CSIR-National Institute of Science Communication and Policy Research (CSIR-NIScPR) along with the Department of Biotechnology and VIBHA. There were 15 programmes, including a mega science and technology exhibition based on the festival theme. Over 8,000 delegates from different parts of India took part in the event. {Read more}

The UPLIN scheme will prove beneficial in numerous ways, including settling and expediting land-related disputes in court and addressing legacy issues such as putting a check on any unwanted change in land revenue records. Terming ULPIN as a "game changer" and the next step in 'SVAMITVA' for digitisation and computerisation of land revenue records, Mathur stressed the importance of 100% coverage of land revenue records in Ladakh and completion of the exercise at the earliest. {Read more}

The Wayanad district administration has attained the meritorious achievement by providing 1,42,563 services to as many as 64,670 tribal beneficiaries as part of the 'Akshaya Big Campaign for Document Digitization (ABCD)'. The campaign is aimed at ensuring basic documents to all citizens belonging to the Scheduled Tribes communities and these documents are digitalized and saved in DigiLocker accounts opened for them. {Read more}

On January 20, Himachal Pradesh government announced to make the state as the first Green Energy State by the end of 2025 by harnessing hydro, hydrogen and solar energy and switching to green products. To ease the norms, the Chief Minister Sukhvinder Singh Sukhu directed the officers to make necessary amendments to the existing power policy and open all the solar projects up to 5 MW capacity for allotment. The state government would also invest in solar plants and will install 500 MW solar projects during the year 2023-24, out of this, 200 MW would be installed by HPPCL. {Read more}

"Material connection" with a brand covers monetary benefits, hotel stay, awards, employment relationships, sweepstakes entries, and media barters. This is in accordance with the 'Consumer Protection Act, 2019'. Non-compliance can lead to a jail term of up to 2 years and penalty of Rs 50 lakh. The size of the social-media influencer market in India last year was Rs 1,275 Crore and by 2025, it was likely to be Rs 2,800 Crore. {Read more}

The Tech Corner will facilitate teachers to conduct techno-pedagogy-enabled classes for their students as well as receive training on the Digital Equalizer Way of Teaching (DEWoT) - a unique method developed by AIF to address all types of learners in the classroom. AIF's DE also launched 'Drone and Satellite Launch Vehicle (DSLV) Mission' on the occasion. {Read more}

The government has allocated a budget of Rs 879.75 Cr for the project including a grant-in-aid of Rs 293.25 Cr (33.33%) and a debt-equity of Rs 586.50 Cr to be raised by entrepreneurs. The project will focus on developing 17 districts in J&K with establishment of processing and marketing infrastructure, providing growth and development opportunities to stakeholders, and facilitating suitable economies of scale in production and post-harvest activities. {Read more}

419. On January 19, Canara Bank entered into a share sale agreement in relation to sale of equity shares held by it in Commercial Indo Bank LLC (CIBL), Moscow, Russia with State Bank of India (SBI). The transaction is expected to be completed on or before 31 March 2023. The consideration of the stake sale is USD 14.67 million (Rs 114 Crore). CIBL, incorporated in the year 2003, is a Joint Venture in Russia between SBI (60%) and Canara Bank (40%). {Read more}

420. Indians remitted \$1.99 billion in November 2022 under the Reserve Bank of India's Liberalised Remittance Scheme (LRS), according to the RBI's bulletin on "Outward Remittances Liberalised Remittance Scheme (LRS) for Resident Individuals" released in January 2023. It is a jump of 29% compared to \$1.54 billion in the year-ago month. Sequentially, outward remittances under the scheme were up about 3.5%. International travel continued to remain over 50% of the entire outward remittance by Indians under the scheme. According to the scheme introduced in 2004, all resident individuals, including minors, are allowed to freely remit up to \$250,000 per financial year for any permissible current or capital account transaction or a combination of both. {Read more}


