What: have been voted the ICC Players of the Month for October

When: published on 9th November 2021

Pakistan's Asif Ali and Ireland's Laura Delany have been voted the ICC Players of the Month for October.

Ali beat Bangladesh's Shakib Al Hasan and Namibia's David Wiese to the men's award, and Delany beat teammate Gaby Lewis and Zimbabwe's Mary-Anne Musonda to the women's prize.

Ali scored 52 runs without defeat across three matches for Pakistan in October at the ICC Men's T20 World Cup, scoring at a strike rate of 273.68.

He first grabbed headlines at the tournament by blasting 27 not out from 12 balls to help Pakistan defeat New Zealand, but it was what he did in the next game that made him a household name.

Red Bull's Max Verstappen celebrated a dominant win in the Mexico City Grand Prix on Sunday to surge 19 points clear of Lewis Hamilton in the Formula One championship with four races remaining. Seven-times world champion Lewis Hamilton was second for Mercedes, holding off Red Bull's Sergio Perez who became the first Mexican to stand on his home podium at a jubilant Autodromo Hermanos Rodriguez.

Red Bull closed the gap to Mercedes in the constructors' standings to one point. "It's still a long way to go but it's, of course, looking good, but also it can turn around very quickly," said Verstappen, 24, of his big step forward in the championship battle.

Damon Galgut won 50,000 pounds in the award ceremony for the book with the narrative of a dysfunctional Afrikaner family and a broken promise to a Black employee, which echoes larger issues in South Africa's post-apartheid transition, AP reported.

Galgut's ninth novel, The Promise, had previously received critical recognition for its dark and bleakly humorous portrayal of the Swart family, the descendants of Dutch colonists who are frantically trying to cling on to their farm and position in post-apartheid South Africa.

Kumar was commissioned into the executive branch of the Navy on January 1, 1983. During his career, he has commanded several warships, including INS Nishank, INS Kora, guided missile destroyer INS Ranvir and aircraft carrier INS Viraat.

Before taking over as the chief of the Western Naval Command, Kumar was the chief of Integrated Defence Staff to the chairperson, Chiefs of Staff Committee.

As part of this research project, funded by National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG), IIT Kanpur has also developed a workflow that allows users to process and analyse declassified imagery of riverine environments at minimal cost and using open source software, a release from Jal Shakti Ministry said.



Shekhawat launched the Ganga Atlas at the 5th edition of 'Ganga Utsav' that began virtually and not only celebrate the glory of river Ganga but of all the rivers of the country, the release said.
