What: was launched to help fishermen by Karnataka

When: published on 14th November 2020

The Coastal Security Police on Friday launched 'Kadalu App' to help fishermen to submit information about their arrival and departure from the fishing harbour using android mobile phones.

The Coastal Security Police conceptualised the app and developed it for the Department of Fisheries. It was launched by Karnataka Minister for Fisheries Kota Srinivasa Poojary at a fishing awareness programme held at Moodukudu, near here.

Coastal Security Police Superintendent of Police R Chetan said that the personnel maintained manually the account of fishing boats leaving and entering the fishing harbour. With the manual system, it was difficult for Coastal Security Police to keep count of the number of fishing boats in deep sea and initiate search and rescue operations when there is inclement weather. The list by TRACE, an anti-bribery standard setting organisation, measures business bribery risk in 194 countries, territories, and autonomous and semi-autonomous regions.

According to this year's data, North Korea, Turkmenistan, South Sudan, Venezuela and Eritrea present the highest commercial bribery risk, while Denmark, Norway, Finland, Sweden and New Zealand present the lowest.

In 2019, India's rank stood 78 position with a score of 48 while in 2020 the country was ranked 77 with a score of 45, the data showed. (Read more)
