Who: LVB

What: to become DBS Bank India, cash withdrawal allowed from Friday

When: published on 26th November 2020

The cabinet approved DBS India's plan to take over capital-starved Lakshmi Vilas Bank NSE 4. 79 % (LVB), paving the way for the first such rescue by a foreign lender. The merger takes effect November 27, when the bar on withdrawals by LVB depositors will be lifted.

DBS India will get LVB's 563 branches, 974 ATMs, 20 lakh depositors and 320,000 borrowers.

"LVB will be amalgamated with DBIL from the appointed date, and with this there will be no further restrictions on the depositors regarding withdrawal of their deposits," the finance ministry said after Wednesday's cabinet meeting chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI), which prepared the final scheme of amalgamation, has given DBS India the right to close down or merge LVB branches. DBS India, the local subsidiary of Singapore's DBS Group Holdings, will invest Rs 2,500 crore while the equity, reserves and surplus of the 94-year-old LVB will be extinguished. (Read more)

India on Tuesday announced a new phase of over 100 high-impact community projects in Afghanistan worth USD 80 million (Rs 592 crore) as the country's development portfolio in the war-ravaged nation has reached over USD 3 billion (Rs 22,200 crore) so far.

The announcement about the new development package was made by External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar during his virtual address at a global conference on Afghanistan during which he also called for an immediate and comprehensive ceasefire to stop violence in that country. (Read more)

What: inaugurates Mega Food Park in Punjab; MFP to benefit 25,000 farmers

Union Minister for Food Processing Industries, Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Rural Development and Panchayati Raj, Narendra Sigh Tomar today virtually inaugurated Mega Food Park (MFP) at Phagwara in Kapurthala district of Punjab. Tomar said that Punjab and Haryana have a significant role in the development of the agriculture sector of India. He added that due to untiring efforts of farmers of these two states, India is not only self-reliant in food grains but is food surplus.

The Union Minister said that Punjab has been ahead in production of rice and wheat, however, due to reduced groundwater levels, diversification of crops is required for which Punjab farmers have taken several steps. He said that the food processing sector needs to be focussed upon so that farmers get fair prices and related sectors can also benefit. (Read more)

What: Launches "Government At Doorstep" Scheme

When: published on 23rd November 2020

From December 1, West Bengal will launch an initiative to take government services to the doorsteps of people. 'Duare Duare Sarkar' or government at the doorstep. That's the name of the initiative that Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee announced at Khatra in Bankura district today. To run till Gandhi Jayanti on January 30, the initiative will try and deliver pending services to people.



"From 11 am to 3 pm every day from December 1, government camps will be held in every block in the state where people can come and demand any service they have not received yet. We will try and provide it right away. If that is not possible, names of all applicants will be listed and the services delivered perhaps to 10 people at a time," Ms Banerjee said.

The new scheme met with criticism from state BJP chief Dilip Ghosh. "Just before elections, you remember adivasis (tribals) and jangalmahal (that includes tribal dominated districts of Bankura, Purulia, West Midnapore and Jhargram). People have understood such announcements are being made just for the polls. She is talking about education for adivasi girls now. What was she doing for 10 years?" (Read more)

What: E-Launches 'National Portal for Transgender Persons' and E-Inaugurates Garima Greh: A Shelter Home for Transgender Persons in Gujarat

Union Minister for Social Justice & Empowerment Shri Thaawarchand Gehlot e-launched a 'National Portal for Transgender Persons' and e-inaugurated a 'Garima Greh: A Shelter Home for Transgender Persons' in Vadodara, Gujarat today in the presence of Ministers of State for Social Justice & Empowerment Shri Krishan Pal Gurjar, Shri Ramdas Athawale, Shri Rattan Lal Kataria; Mr. Laxmi Narayan Tripathi, Member, National Council for Transgenders and Shri. R. Subrahmanyam, Secretary, M/o of Social Justice and Empowerment.

Addressing on the occasion Shri Thaawarchand Gehlot said that this National Portal for Transgender Persons has been developed within 2 months of Notification of Transgender Persons (Protectionof Rights) Rules, 2020 on 29 September, 2020. This highly useful Portal would help a transgender person in applying for a Certificate and Identity card digitally from anywhere in the country. The most important benefit is that it helps the transgender person to get the I-Card without any physical interface and without having to visit any office, the Minister said. Through the Portal, they can monitor the status of their application that ensures transparency in the process. The issuing authorities are also under strict timelines to process the applications and issue certificates and identity cards without any necessary delays. Once the Certificate and I-card are issued, the applicant can download them from the Portal itself. In case of delay or rejection, the applicant has the options to submit grievances through



the Portal which are forwarded to the concerned person and will be resolved at the earliest. The Issuing authorities through the Dashboard provided to them can view the number of applications received, the applications approved and the applications which are pending or put on hold so that they can take the required necessary action from their end. He hoped that this portal will help a lot of people from the community to come forward and get Transgender Certificate and Identity Cards as per their self-perceived identity which is an important provision of The Transgender Persons (Protection of Rights) Act, 2019. "The Central Water Commission has already approved the design of the Song Dam Drinking Water Project that costs around Rs 1100 crore," the tweet added.



The press release added, "This scheme, will provide 24-hour drinking water to the city of Dehradun and will give a rebirth to River Rispana. It one of the most important projects of our government. Originally built on the Song River, the dam is about 148 meters high and aims to generate power up to six megawatts. "(Read more)

What: wins 2nd term as Burkina Faso president

Roch Marc Christian Kabore has won a second term as president of Burkina Faso, according to

provisional results announced by the country's election commission on Thursday.



The 63-year-old head of the ruling People's Movement for Progress party secured 57. 87% votes in the Nov. 22 polls to claim victory in the first round, said Newton Ahmed Barry, the head of the Independent National Electoral Commission (CENI).

The result gives Kabore another five years in the office that he has held since 2015.

Eddie Komboigo and Zephirin Diabre received 15. 45% and 12. 46%, respectively, of the nearly 3 million votes cast, Barry said.

Voter turnout was at around 50%, according to CENI data, with more than 53% men and over 46% women.

Some 38% of the voters were aged between 20 and 35. (Read more)
