Who: Indian Railways

What: to develop an Art Gallery with Souvenir Shop at Kevadiya Railway Station

When: published on 2nd November 2021

Indian Railways will develop an Art Gallery with Souvenir Shop at Kevadiya Railway Station under Public-Private Partnership. This Art Gallery showcases different Art and Craft forms of Gujarat and India. Now, tourists visiting the Statue of Unity can experience the rich cultural history of Gujarat at Kevadiya Station itself. Vadodara Division of Western Railway has awarded first its kind contract in Indian Railways for the development of Art Gallery with Souvenir Shop.

This Art Gallery will be developed and operated by a private party with earnings to Railways of 24.7 lakh rupees and potential revenue of 2.83 crore rupees. This concept will not only enrich the experience of people visiting Kevadiya, but on the social front, this unique concept will also provide employment to the local tribal people of the Narmada district by giving them an opportunity to promote their tribal art.

What: Takes Charge as GOC of Indian Army's Western Command

Lieutenant General Nav K Khanduri, took over as the General Officer Commanding-in-Chief, Western Command at Chandigarh on Monday. He is the first Air Defence Officer to be appointed as an Army Commander.

On assuming his new appointment, Gen Khanduri laid a wreath at the Veer Smriti war memorial to pay homage to the martyrs. A guard of honour was also presented to him at the Western Command Headquarters.



An alumnus of Rashtriya Indian Military College, Dehradun and the National Defence Academy, Khadakwasla, he passed out with the 73rd Regular Course from the Indian Military Academy, Dehradun and was commissioned into 27 Air Defence Regiment (Amritsar Airfield) in December 1983.

Who: Akash Kumar

What: ensures India's first medal at World Boxing Championships

When: published on 2nd November 2021

Akash Kumar dazzled with his burst of speed and relentless attacks to upset 2016 Rio Olympics bronze medallist Yoel Finol in the quarter-finals and ensure India's first medal at the World Boxing Championships in Belgrade, Serbia.

The 21-year-old bantamweight fighter made a terrific start, going all out with his punches, and kept up the intensity throughout the three rounds. Such was his confidence that he was teasing Finol to have a go at him, lowering his guard. The flurry of blows from Kumar kept getting heavier as the bout progressed and a unanimous verdict saw him through to the semi-finals.

He became only the seventh Indian to win a world championship medal. India returned with two medals from the previous edition—Amit Panghal (51kg) won silver and Manish Kaushik (63kg) bronze. Five Indians made it to quarter-finals this time.

The minister inaugurated the launching function of three Floating Border Out-Posts (FBOP) for the Border Security Force and two Fully Electric Autonomous Ferries for ASKO Maritime AS, Norway, which are amongst the world's first autonomous ferries.

Members include Chairman, Railway Board; Secretaries of Ministry/Department of Road, Transport & Highways; Ports, Shipping & Waterways; Civil Aviation; Petroleum & Natural Gas; Power; Telecommunications; Coal; Mines; Chemicals & Petro-Chemicals; Fertilizers; Steel; Expenditure; DPIIT; Food and Public Distribution; Agriculture & Farmers Welfare; Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying; and Tourism. Head of Logistics Division will be the Member, Convenor. Besides, the EGoS can co-opt any other Secretary or Secretaries as per requirement.
