Eight candidates from $A$ to $G$ appeared for an exam on $5^{\text {th }}$ and $12^{\text {th }}$ of different months viz. April, May, June and July such that on one day only one candidate appeared for exam. D had appeared before two candidates but not before $B$ and $E$. Only $C$ had appeared between $A$ and $B$, who had his exam on $5^{\text {th }}$ of an even numbered month. $F$ and $B$ appeared in consecutive months but not on consecutive turns. $G$ was among the last two candidates that appeared for exam. F has his exam before G . Only one candidate appeared between H and E .

2. Who among the following has exam(s) on even numbered dates of odd numbered months?

## COMMON EXPLANATION:

## Reference:

D had appeared before two candidates but not before B and E .
Only $C$ had appeared between $A$ and $B$, who had his exam on 5 th of an even numbered month.

## Inference:

Case 1: When B has his exam on 5th April

Case 2: When B has his exam on 5th June

|  | 12 | E |

## Reference:

F and B appeared in consecutive months but not on consecutive turns.
$F$ has his exam before $G$.
G was among the last two candidates that appeared for exam.

## Inference:

Case 1: When B has his exam on 5th April

The only left date for E is 5th June because E can't have exam after D as per previous hints.

| Month | Date | Candidates |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| April | 5 | B |

|  | 12 | F |
| June | 5 | E |
|  | 12 | D |
| July | 5 | $\mathrm{G} /$ |

Case 2: When B has his exam on 5th June

| Month | Date | Candidates |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| April | 5 |  |
|  | 12 |  |
| May | 5 | A |
|  | 12 | C |
| June | 5 | B |
|  | 12 | D |
| July | 5 | F |
|  | 12 | G |

## Reference:

Only two candidates appeared between H and E .

## Inference:

Case 2 fails, as E and H are at consecutive positions here.

Case 1: When B has his exam on 5th April

Therefore H appeared on 5th July and G on 12th July.

| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| April | 5 | B |
|  | 12 | C |
| May | 5 | A |
|  | 12 | F |
| June | 5 | E |

| July | 5 | H |
|  | 12 | G |

## Answers :

1. Following the common explanation, we get
$H$ has his exam on $5^{\text {th }}$ July.
Hence option C is correct.
2. Following the common explanation, we get

F and $G$ had their exams on $12^{\text {th }}$ (even) of odd numbered months i.e. May and July.

Hence option D is correct.
3. Following the common explanation, we get

After arranging all the persons in alphabetical order, position of one person i.e. E will remain unchanged.

Hence option B is correct.

4. Following the common explanation, we get
$B$ has exam on $5^{\text {th }}$ April.

Hence option A is correct.
5. Following the common explanation, we get

G's exam is in the last.

Hence option D is correct.
