10 persons from A to J performed in a Dance competition on 14th and 25th of each mont11 sweets viz. Gulab jamun, Peda, Barfi, Rasmalai, Kalakand, Kaju Katli, Laddu, Ghevar, Rasgulla, Kaju Kalash and Rajbhog were prepared by a sweet shop from 1st to 11th of a month such that only one sweet is prepared on one day.

Gulab jamun was prepared 5 days before Laddu, which was prepared on a prime numbered date. Only three sweets were prepared between Laddu and Kaju Katli. Kaju Kalash was prepared immediately before Gulab jamun. At least 3 sweets were prepared after Ghevar. 2 sweets were prepared between Ghevar and Kaju Katli. Number of sweets prepared before Rasgulla is 1 more than that of after Ghevar. Barfi was not prepared consecutive to Rasgulla. Peda was prepared 5 days before Kaju Katli. Peda was prepared just before Rajbhog. Kalakand was prepared before but not immediately before Rasmalai.

Gulab jamun was prepared 5 days before Laddu, which was prepared on a prime numbered date.
Only three sweets were prepared between Laddu and Kaju Katli.
Kaju Kalash was prepared immediately before Gulab jamun.

With the given following 3 cases can be prepared.

## Case2 fails to satisfy the last hint, thus it gets eliminated.

Case1 gets eliminated as it does not fulfill the last hint.

## Answers :

1. From Common Explanation we have

No sweet was prepared before Barfi.
Hence option E is correct.
2. From Common Explanation we have

Kalakand was prepared 3 days before Laddu.

Hence option C is correct.
3. From Common Explanation we have

Kaju Kalash is the odd one out as rest were prepared on composite numbered dates.
Hence option D is correct.
4. From Common Explanation we have

Number of sweets prepared before Rajbhog is 2.

Similarly number of sweets prepared after Rasgulla is also 2.
Hence option A is correct.
5. From Common Explanation we have

Gulab jamun was prepared exactly in the middle of these 11 days.
Hence option B is correct.
