Directions: Study the following information carefully and answer the questions given beside.

Eight persons are sitting around a circular table such that some of them are facing towards the centre while some are facing away from centre. M is third to the right of S, who sits second to the left of Y. P sits on the immediate right of X, who faces the same direction as faced by M. Neither X nor P is adjacent to M. C is third to the left of Y. Not more than 4 persons face outside. B and S face same direction. C is third to the right of B. J is second to the left of M. C and J face opposite direction to that of B. Immediate neighbors of C face opposite directions.


### **Common explanation:**

#### Reference:

M is third to the right of S, who sits second to the left of Y. C is third to the left of Y.

#### Inference:

Following cases can be prepared with the given hints.





#### Reference:

P sits on the immediate right of X, who faces the same direction as faced by M. Neither X nor P is adjacent to M.

#### Inference:

Case2 and 3 fail to satisfy the given hints. Further two cases arise from Case-1 and Case-4 which are named as Case-1A and Case-4A.





#### Reference:


C is third to the right of B.
J is second to the left of M.
B and S face same direction.
Immediate neighbors of C face opposite directions.
Not more than 4 persons face outside.

#### Inference:

Case-4A eliminated as it violates the last hint.

Case-1A and 4 eliminated as they violate the second hint where J is to be placed second to the left of M.

Thus only Case-1 fulfills all the given hints.




#### Reference:

C and J face opposite direction to that of B.

#### Inference:

The final arrangement can be obtained as follows.







#### **Answers:**

**1.** Following the common explanation, we have

5 persons face towards centre.

Hence option D is correct.

**2.** Following the common explanation, we have

J is third to the left of P.

Hence option B is correct.

**3.** Following the common explanation, we have

P is the odd one out as all others except P face towards centre.

Hence option E is correct.

X is second to the right of C.

Hence option A is correct.

**5.** Following the common explanation, we have

4 persons sit between J and B when counted from the right of former.

Hence option D is correct.
