Directions: Study the following information carefully and answer the questions given beside.

9 persons from A to I sit around a circular table such that some of them face towards centre while some face away from centre. C sits third to the right of B. F sits second to the left of C, who is on the immediate left of A. Both A and C face same direction. D sits third to the left of F. Only 2 persons sit between E and H when counted from right of H. H is not adjacent to C. Neither E nor H is adjacent to A. Immediate neighbors of D face opposite directions. J is third to the left of E. J and I face same direction but do not sit adjacent. Immediate neighbors of B face the same direction as faced by B. I does not face centre.

1. How many persons sit between F and J when counted from the right of J?

- A. 2 B. 3 C. 5 D. 6 E. None of these

2. What is the difference between the persons who face towards the centre and the persons who do not face towards centre?

- A. 1 B. 3 C. 4 D. No difference at all E. None of these

Common explanation :

Reference:

C sits third to the right of B.

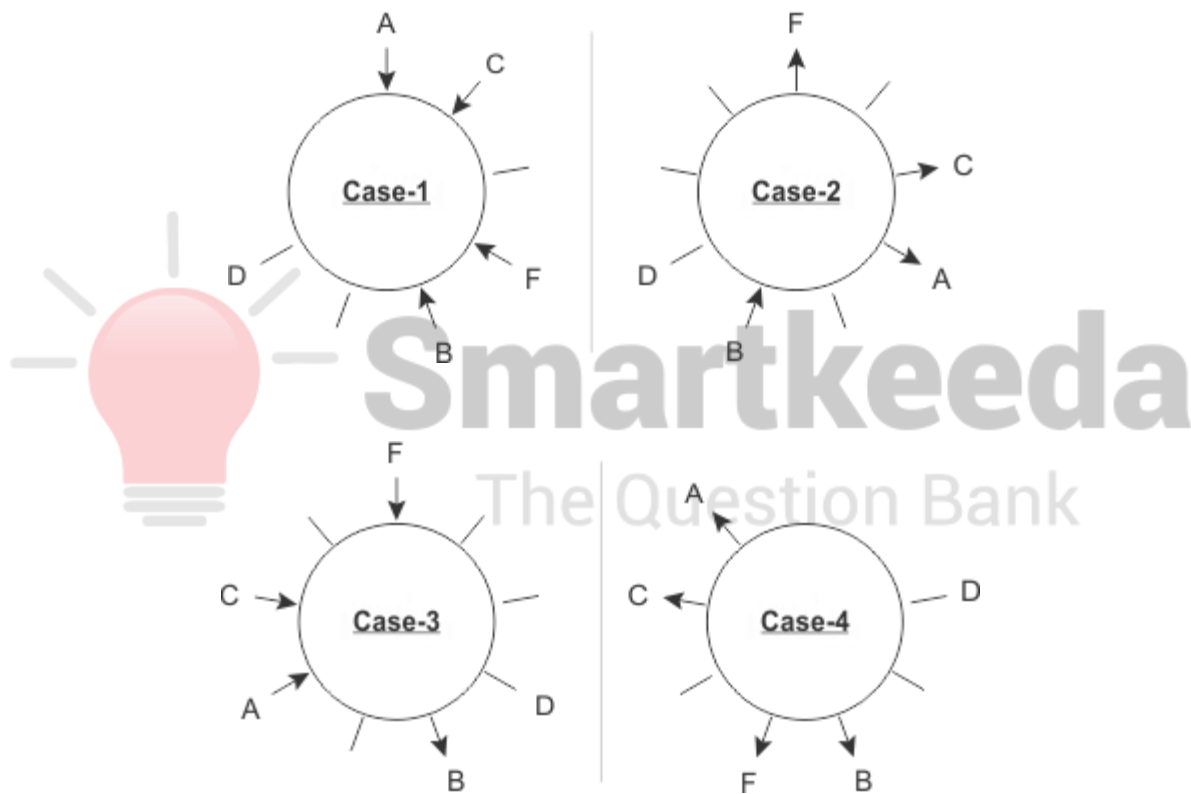
F sits second to the left of C, who is on the immediate left of A.

D sits third to the left of F.

Both A and C face same direction.

Inference:

Following cases are possible with the given hints.



Reference:

Immediate neighbors of B face the same direction as faced by B.

Immediate neighbors of D face opposite directions.

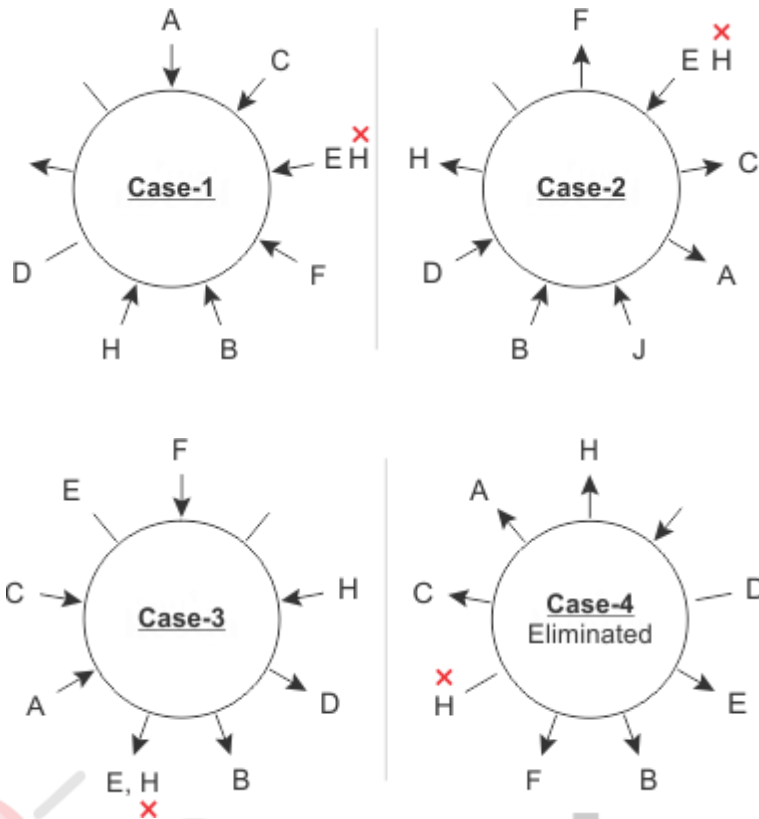
Only 2 persons sit between E and H when counted from right of H.

H is not adjacent to C.

Neither E nor H is adjacent to A.

Inference:

Case-4 gets eliminated as it violates the last hint.



Reference:

J is third to the left of E.

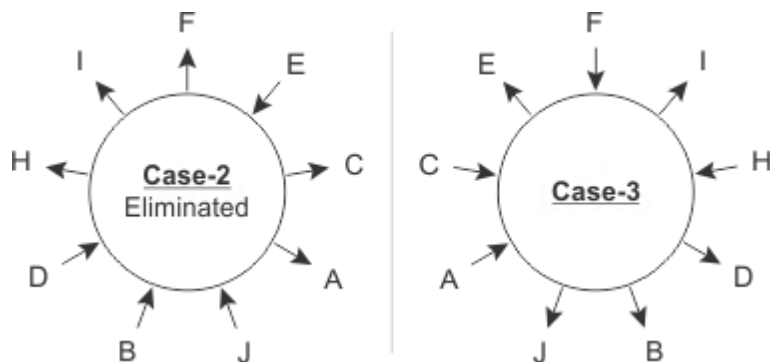
J and I face same direction but do not sit adjacent.

I does not face centre.

Inference:

Case-1 gets eliminated as it violates the first hint.

Case-2 gets eliminated as it violates the second hint.



Answers:

- 1.** Following the common explanation, we have

3 persons sit between F and J when counted from the right of J.

Hence option B is correct.
- 2.** Following the common explanation, we have

The persons facing away from centre are 5 while the persons facing towards the centre are 4.

Required difference = 1.

Hence option A is correct.
- 3.** Following the common explanation, we have

J is the odd one out as rest face towards the centre.

Hence option E is correct.
- 4.** Following the common explanation, we have

D sits second to the left of J.

Hence option B is correct.
- 5.** Following the common explanation, we have

5 persons sit between A and D, when counted from left of A.

Hence option C is correct.



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
