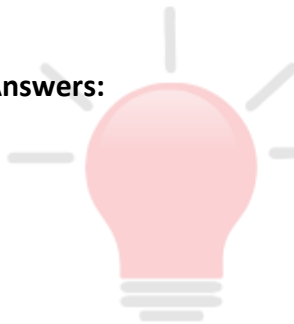

Common explanation:

Change in words: Words are arranged on the basis of ascending order of the number of consonants in a word i.e. The word with lowest number of consonants is placed at left end at first. Only one word is rearranged at each step.

Change in numbers: The numbers are rearranged at the extreme left end as per ascending order. Only one number is rearranged at each step.

Note- Changes in word and number take place simultaneously at each step.

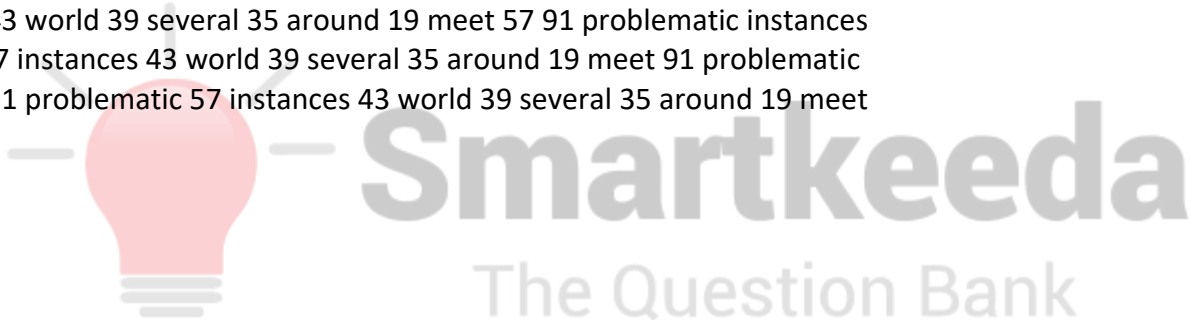
Step II: 35 around 19 meet world 57 91 several 39 problematic 43 instances

Answers :

1. From the common explanation, we get

The fifth element from left end in step IV is '35' and third to the right of 35 is 'meet'.

Hence, Option C is correct.

2. From the common explanation, we get

'several' comes exactly between 'around' and 'world' in the final output.

Hence option B is correct.

3. From the common explanation, we get

'meet' is on the immediate left of 'world' in step III.

Hence, Option D is correct.

4. From the common explanation, we get

57 - several is the odd one out as in rest pairs both elements have same position from left and right end.

Hence, Option E is correct.

5. From the common explanation, we get

"35 around 19 meet world 57 91 several 39 problematic 43 instances" is the step II.

Hence, Option B is correct.
